The mission of GLAD is to ensure equal access of the deaf and hard of hearing community to the same opportunities afforded their hearing counterparts. Our general purposes and powers are directed around the promotion of the social, recreational, cultural, educational, and vocational welfare of our deaf and hard of hearing consumers. GLAD's specific and primary purpose is to act as a coordinating agency that addresses the broad social service needs of deaf and hard of hearing people through direct service provision, advocacy, research, and dissemination of information regarding deafness to parents, professionals, and consumers.

Today, GLAD directly serves clients through the main headquarters at the Community Center in Eagle Rock and at outreach offices throughout our service area of Los Angeles, Kern, Orange, Ventura, Santa Barbara, Riverside, San Luis Obispo, San Bernardino, Inyo and Mono counties.

GLAD is a member of the California Coalition of Agencies Serving the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (CCASDHH).
