Special Services Staff

A Special Services staff is available to assist students. Academic and basic skills tutoring, reinforcement of vocational course work, sign language interpreting, and job placement assistance are available for students with physical, learning, emotional and developmental disabilities and for enrollees who are hearing or visually impaired or have a history of substance abuse. Clients of the State Department of Rehabilitation are eligible for Workability II job placement assistance.

Practical and social skills in communication, daily living, reading, writing, computation, safety and leisure.

Course Number: 43-15-51
