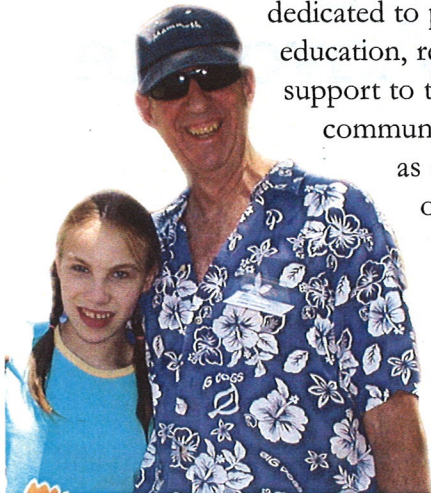
What is Autism?

Autism is a complex neurobiological disorder that impacts development in the areas of social interaction, verbal and non-verbal communication, and behavior. Autism typically appears in early childhood and affects each individual differently with symptoms ranging from mild to severe. According to the Centers for Disease Control, 1 in 150 children is diagnosed with autism. Currently, we know very little about what causes autism, but there are treatments and educational approaches that may be beneficial in reducing the challenges associated with this disorder. Autism knows no racial, ethnic or social boundaries. It can affect any family and child anywhere in the world.



What is Foothill Autism Alliance?

Foothill Autism Alliance, Inc. (FAA) is a non-profit, all-volunteer organization of parents, professionals, adults with autism, and care-givers, dedicated to providing education, resources, and support to the autism community. 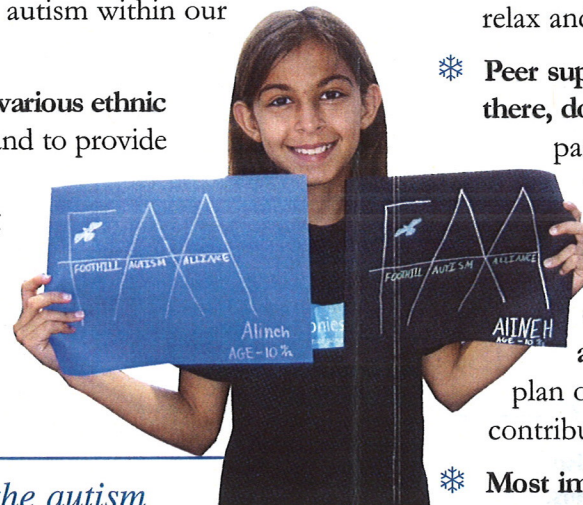


Our Vision:
