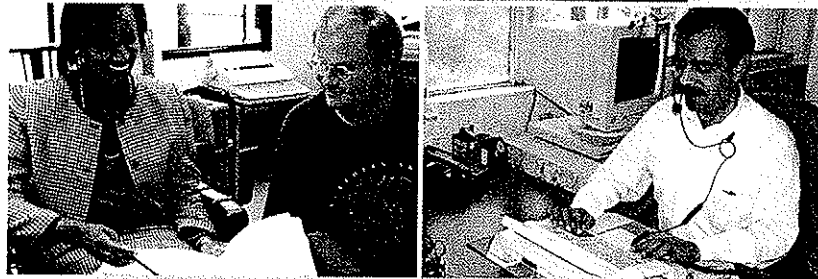

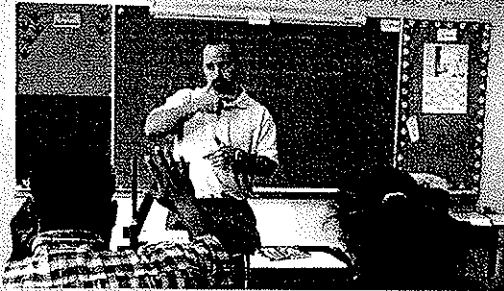


EmployABILITY HOTLINE

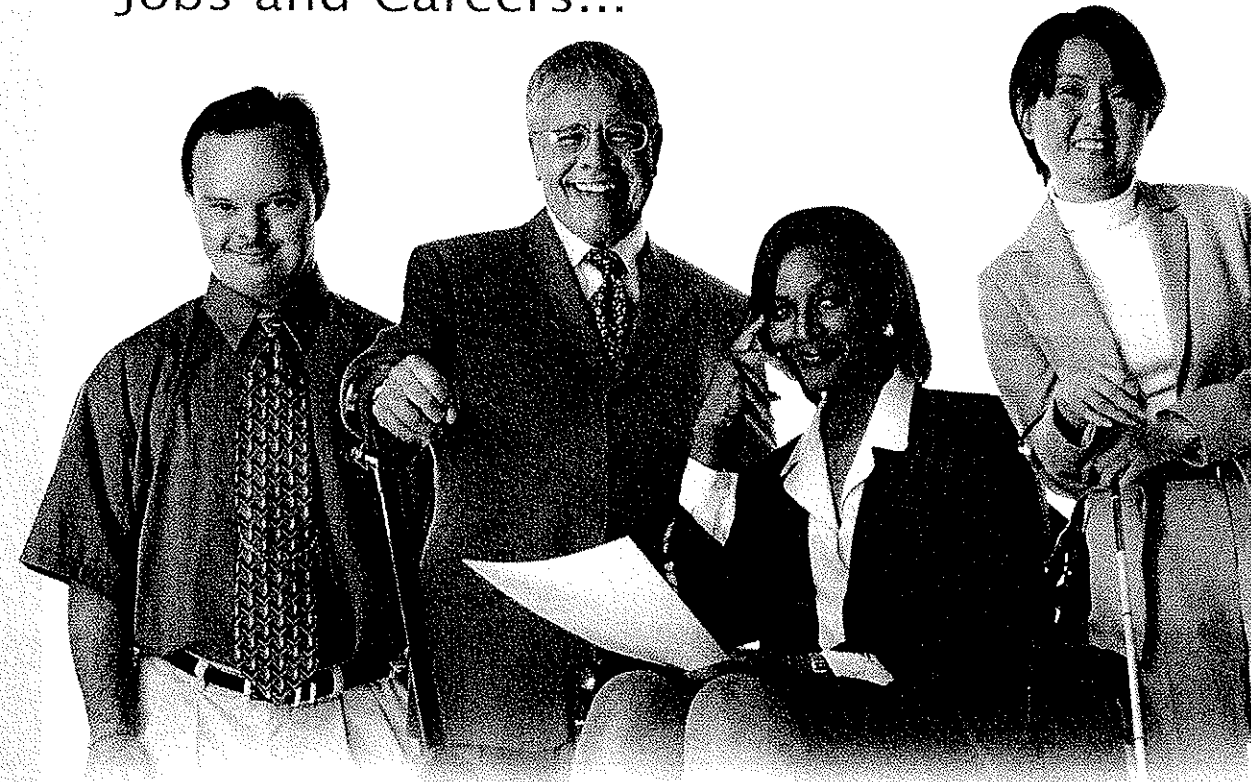

Additional Services for Job Seekers with Disabilities

- Abilities assessment to determine need for special accommodations/training
- Computers and equipment with adaptive technology
- TTY/TDD machines
- Alternative format materials - enlarged print, Braille, audiotape
- American Sign Language (ASL) interpreters, Assistive Listening Devices
- Access to Department of Rehabilitation services
- Assistance in working with employers to receive workplace accommodations
