

Do You Have Concerns About Your Baby?

Most babies at...

10 Weeks Startle to sound. Hold up their head Look at objects.

onths Reach for objects. Turn their heads towards sounds. Roll over, Hold toys.

Months Continue to babble. Sit alone.
Imitate actions.

Year Take their first steps. Respond to their own name. Play with a variety of toys.

8 Months Walk alone. Build a tower of three blocks. Use up to 20 words. Enjoy interacting with caregivers.

2 Years Begin to use two-word phrases to communicate. Walk up and down the stairs. Eat and drink independently.
