



Early Start Transition Meeting

When a child reaches 2.6 years of age, a transition planning meeting is scheduled with:

- Family
- School District Representative
- Service Coordinator

This meeting is intended to discuss:

- Steps necessary to support transition to special education or other services
- The necessary assessments to determine eligibility for special education services
- The steps involved in developing the IEP
- The types of school placement options available

Transition Timeline

2 years, 6 months

- Transition Meeting with service coordinator, district personnel and parents
- Team decides which assessments are necessary, and develops an assessment plan

15 days later

- Assessment plan provided to parents (sent via mail or email)

60 days later

- Assessment have been completed
- IEP team meets to develop an IEP

3 years

- Child starts receiving services through the school district
