- All summer sessions will be 5 nights in length, operating Monday through Saturday mornings.
- Session enrollment will likely be reduced in our efforts to ensure a safe environment for both campers and staff.
- Registration will not be “open” as in previous years. Camp staff will be registering individuals as spaces become available to ensure that all applicants meet the “Eligibility Requirements” listed below.
- Drop off and pick up procedures will be revised to minimize contact between those accompanying campers and other campers and staff.

Activities include: Swimming, horseback riding, nature studies, adaptive sports and recreation, and arts & crafts.
