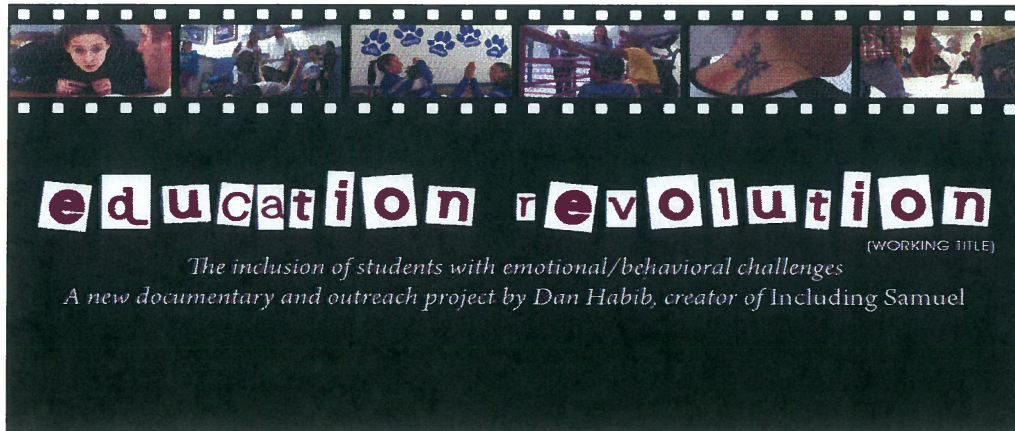

parents need so they feel equipped to fully include these students?
How are behavioral problems linked to communication and learning disabilities?***

- Demonstrate innovative educational approaches to discipline, dropout prevention and improve school climate
- Foster a broader dialogue about the benefits and challenges of fully including ALL students in our schools and communities
- Strengthen the capacity among educators, students, youth-serving organization and communities to successfully include and education students with complex behavioral challenges
