DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the East—take the Santa Monica Fwy (10) west to the National Blvd. off ramp. Cross National and proceed straight on Manning. Turn left on Motor Avenue. Make a left approx 1/2 block into the Main Entrance.

From the South, North or West—take the San Diego Fwy (405) to the Santa Monica Fwy (10) going East. Exit at National/Overland. Turn left on National Blvd. (DO NOT TURN LEFT OR RIGHT ONTO MOTOR BETWEEN 7-10 AM) Turn right on Vinton, another right on Woodbine. Right on Motor, crossing National Blvd. The Main Entrance is less than 1/2 block on the right.

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DR. KYLE PRUETT

Dr. Pruett is recognized as a prominent author, international lecturer, media personality and pioneering researcher. Dr. Pruett has conducted the country's only long-term study of the impact on children by primary caretaking fathers. As one of the most respected experts on child and family development, Dr. Kyle Pruett is considered a parenting visionary who takes parents deep into the hearts and minds of their children. He puts the emotional well-being of children right where it belongs: at the center of child development.

Dr. Pruett is an award winning author of *The Nurturing Father* and *Fatherneed*. Coupling fatherhood with parenting, he has hosted the television series *Your Child Six to Twelve with Dr. Kyle Pruett*. A frequent contributor to the *New York Times*, *Good Housekeeping*, and *Child*, he serves as a consultant for *CBS Morning News* and has appeared on *Good Morning America*, *Oprah*, *CBS This Morning*, and *NPR*.

Dr. Pruett's unique mix of lecture and discussion is a daylong interactive workshop, linking the fresh evidence-based clinical neuroscience of paternal engagement and child outcomes to hands-on father involvement and co-parenting practice.

Participants will learn ways of positively and actively engaging fathers into their regular routines and how to make those routines more father friendly. Participants will also learn how paternal care differs from maternal care and why those differences can positively affect child outcomes and family functioning.



CONFERENCE INFORMATION

Dr. Pruett will present a day-long interactive workshop on the clinical significance of paternal engagement on child and family development.

The morning session will focus on how fathering differs from mothering and why it matters to child outcomes. He will present research that prepares the way for revamping current approaches to families around paternal engagement strategies.

In the afternoon, Dr. Pruett will present the newest findings from his own award-winning research on paternal engagement with special emphasis on how such engagement affects maternal behavior.

The day will end with small-group discussions of how our agencies and institutions can integrate father-friendly practices into their programming.
