CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. DeBoer moved to approve the minutes of February 10, 2016, Ms. Richman seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

HOPE (Home Ownership for Personal Empowerment)

Mr. Martin, Executive Director - HOPE, made a presentation to the Committee on the concept of HOPE securing real properties in the Lanterman catchment area for the benefit of Lanterman clients. HOPE is a non-profit housing corporation dedicated to providing affordable housing in the community for people with developmental disabilities.

Mr. Martin offered a sample project with models and programs for the populations the Center might consider to serve. The Committee engaged in dialoged and asked questions.

The Committee agreed by consensus for Mr. Martin to research options in Lanterman's catchment area for further discussion.

The Center had established a time limited Committee consisting of Dina Richman, Larry DeBoer, Mark Higgins, Patrick Aulicino, Frank Lara, and Claudia Ayala to review the proposals, participate in the interview process, and make a recommendation on a selected realtor/broker to represent the Center. Ms. Richman reported that the Committee unanimously agreed to recommend that the Center engage CRESA as the Center's broker.

Mr. DeBoer moved to recommend that the Board engage CRESA as the Center's broker, Ms. Richman seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
