CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Trevizo-Reinoso called the meeting to order at 10:03 A.M. via Zoom.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of October 12, 2022 were tabled for the next meeting since there was no quorum.

PERFORMANCE REVIEW-Q3

Mr. Manicone reviewed the 2022 Performance Plan-Q3. He reported that DDS is making an adjustment this year and this performance plan will be good for 18 months: 2023 to the end of June 2024. In July 2024, we will start an annual performance contract again and it will be in sync with the fiscal year. The committee did not have any suggestions for changes, but they did have some questions and comments.

Mr. Perri appreciates the slow and steady progress reflected on the performance plan. Mr. Goodus is very happy about the employment numbers.

Ms. Ovsepyan added that the Center has been working with the clients who are in IMDs (locked psychiatric facilities). By next quarter, the number of clients there will most likely be 2. This is attributed to the efforts of service coordinators

OTHER

Mr. Manicone asked the committee what agenda items they'd like to discuss in 2023.

Ms. Moralls would like to learn more about employment, paid internships and clarification about what Ms. Carmen Jimenez-Wynn's role is at Lanterman. Final rule should also be an agenda item.

Mr. Goodus would like to talk about alternative day services and tailored-day services. He suggested a collaboration between regional centers, service providers and families. Mental health should also be an agenda item.

Mr. Perri would like to talk about remote work and those changes.

Ms. Trevizo-Reinoso would like a joint meeting with the SPAC committee to discuss services, rate reform, and advocacy.

Lastly, Ms. Ovsepyan thanked Easter Seals for supporting a Lanterman client to register to vote for the first time.
